



PRODUCT:

Whelk

SCIENTIFIC NAME:

Buccinum undatum

DISTRIBUTION:

Distributed across the North Atlantic Ocean, from New Jersey, Canada and Arctic islands up to Northwest Europe

FISHING AREA:

FAO 27, predominantly around the coasts of the UK and Normandy (FR).

FISHING METHOD:

Fished from small vessels (dayboats) using baited traps

SUSTAINABILITY:

Non threatened species, collected without damage to the marine environment and with a minimum of by-catch. Therefore it is regarded as a sustainable product.

PRESENTATION:

Fresh live, chilled, frozen

PACKAGING FORMS:

Nets, trays, bags, buckets
